Turkey Shoot November 12th rifle and pistol November 19th shotguns, 10 am

We will be shooting rifles at bulls-eye targets, **closest bullet to the center** on a single shot wins the match. Classes are as follows: 22 rimfire at 50 yards, factory and modified centerfire rifle at 100 yards. We will have some full blown benchrest rifles out there to shoot for anyone that shows up. Practice time will be allowed a few times during the day. \$3 per match, 5 shooters minimum.

We will be shooting pistols at bulls-eye targets, **closest bullet to the center** on a single shot wins the match. Classes are as follows: 22 rimfire and centerfire pistol at 15 to 25 yards. Practice time will be allowed a few times during the day. \$3 per match, 5 shooters minimum.

The skeet guys will be doing **crazy quails**. That is a game where you walk a path on the skeet field and a bird is pulled at random. LOTS O' FUN!!!! \$3/shooter/10 targets.

The trap range will be doing wobble traps, wolf chase and Annie Oakleys \$3/shooter/10 targets.
