Due to cost increases in the clays, shipping increases and surcharges, we have to raise the trap and skeet fees from **\$2.50 and \$4.00 to \$3.00 and \$5.00** for a round of birds. We are also going to apply any extra revenue to getting a **new thrower** for the doubles house. This is the first change in at least 6 years at the range and we are still significantly cheaper than most of the other ranges.
